**Pure Rural**  A mix of very rural areas and small cities with some suburban areas.

**Rural-suburban Mix**  Significant suburban and rural populations with almost no dense urban areas.

**Sparse suburban**  Predominantly suburban, with a mixture of sprawling exurb-style neighborhoods and denser neighborhoods typical of inner-ring suburbs. Often contains a small rural population and a small urban core.

**Dense suburban**  Predominantly suburban, especially denser inner-ring suburbs, Also significant urban populations.

**Urban-suburban mix**  A mix of urban areas and inner-ring suburbs.

**Pure urban**  Almost entirely dense urban neighborhoods.
