Pure Rural 🏡 🏡 A mix of very rural areas and small cities with some suburban areas.

Rural-suburban Mix 🏡 🏡 Significant suburban and rural populations with almost no dense urban areas.

Sparse suburban 🏡 🏡 Predominantly suburban, with a mixture of sprawling exurb-style neighborhoods and denser neighborhoods typical of inner-ring suburbs. Often contains a small rural population and a small urban core.

Dense suburban 🏡 🏡 Predominantly suburban, especially denser inner-ring suburbs, Also significant urban populations.

Urban-suburban mix 🏡 🏡 A mix of urban areas and inner-ring suburbs.

Pure urban 🏡 🏡 Almost entirely dense urban neighborhoods.
